The Challenge for IT

IT underpins everyday working for all the Atrium Staff. The Microsoft Azure based Windows Virtual Desktop (WVD) solution was selected as the preferred option - it fulfilled the Atrium remote working requirements as well as having flexible technology and pricing options.
